Trails

Trail work day - trail 7 and 2a -

Polaris Ranger Update - We received a 10,000 grant from Polaris towards purchase of a Ranger for grooming/trail equipment. The club voted to accept the grant and purchase the Ranger. Board got quotes from M&M and Kromminga dealerships. 1000 CC/900 cc full window doors, windshield wiper kit, windshield front and back, 8/10 ply tires. Looked at revamping the doors, tip out windshield. Recommendation from the board 1000 cc approx \$17,570 or 900cc approx \$15,450. Kromminga is lower than M&M.

Either one can take tracks.

Board recommends - 900 cc 2 seat winch, full front windshield, 8/10 ply tires, windshield wiper kit - \$15,500 plus tax

Question asked on how insurance is handled - should be able to add to current policy. Chris Stebral will look into.

Derrick makes a motion for the 900cc with the winch, full front windshield, windshield wiper, 10 ply tires-\$15,500 Dean miller - second - Motion approved.
