## Trails

- Trail 1 Bridge Semi trailer is getting delivered to Chris Stebral's by the end of October. Chris provided an update about the trailers at Iowa City Brake. Donnie said they could be stored at the farm.
- Mohawk Trail Bridge/Shueyville This was discussed along with the Shueyville Trail.
- 965 Trail Updates from Pickering on ditch crossings. Could use two 20 foot bridges to make it across the ditch near RTL Equipment.

- Lisbon Trail needs a longer bridge. The one there currently is getting short.
- HWY 13 will need help.
- Ely larger bridge will need dirt and rock. Horse trail area a spot has washed out pretty bad. Could use a tube and then rock and dirt.
- October 15<sup>th</sup> we can begin working.
- Donnie and Dean will need help on their trails since harvest will run late this year.
- Derek Dunkin is going to reach out to Derek Parker and see about meeting with Tiffin and North Liberty. With both towns growing our trail systems are being effected.
- September 28<sup>th</sup> National Lands Day. Work on trails on government ground.
- Joe Latta will be organizing a trail boss meeting. Look for email from Joe. At that time the landowner list will be reviewed.
- Equipment Update Chris will have the mowers back to Millers before the trail work day.
- Questions on becoming a groomer operator ISSA Convention will have a groomer class

#### **New Business**

- Groomer The board met before the meeting reviewed different groomers that were for sale by Track Inc. and recommended to the club that we look at purchasing a 1989 Tucker Sno-Cat Model 2000-D for up to \$26,000. Please see additional page for proposal and photo of the groomer. Club had general discussion around the groomer and what to do with Dewey. Donnie Miller made a motion to purchase the 1989 Tucker SnoCat from Track Inc for up to \$26000 pending that Chris Handley goes up to see the groomer before purchase. Second Erik Vosmek Approved 26 Yes 5 No. Majority of board members were present Seth Allender, Sarah Allender, Chris Handley, Brad Dvorksy and Mark Smyth.
- Groomer Certification Sarah will send out the current groomer certification list with information on the upcoming groomer classes. A club member asked what age is required to operate a groomer. Required age is 18. Question was posed if the group would consider hiring kids depending on age limit to operate the groomers since it is difficult to get operators.
- Rental Tractor Mark Smyth provided an update on the rental tractor. We can get it from Kromminga's with our same rate as last year. They will deliver it whenever we ask.
   Joe Latta made a motion to get the rental tractor end of October. Erik Vosmek – Second – Approved
- ROW Permits Bill will work on getting these filed with the DOT.

- Meeting Locations Derek Dunkin said Club 76 is interested in hosting a meeting and they would like to provide food for the meeting. Tentatively put Club 76 as the March 12<sup>th</sup> Location.
- Trail Maps List of map sponsors was provided at the meeting. We really only have space for new sponsors if some drop off. Will send out email with the sponsor list and the cost of the ads.
- Haunted Trail Derrick is looking for volunteers to help with the Haunted Trails put on by Friends of Coralville Lake on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>. It's at the Sugar Bottom Day Use area. Contact Derrick is interested in volunteering or attend the Haunted Trail if not busy.
- Ranger Usage Chris Handley brought up that during the board meeting they discussed
  that Friends of Coralville Lake would like to use the Ranger during the evening. It is the
  same day as our trail work day. Derrick will arrange to get it to and from people for trail
  work. Group discussion around liability and use of the Ranger. Chris Handley made a
  motion that The SnowDrifters will allow the Friends of Coralville Lake to Utilize the
  Ranger for their Haunted Trails event in the evening but they must provide proof of
  insurance and coverage for the Ranger during the event. Second Brad Dvorsky –
